PILEATED GIBBON BORN AT THE GIBBON & GALLINACEOUS BIRD CENTER

A wild-caught 25-year-old pileated gibbon (*Hylobates pileatus*) gave birth to a male infant at the Gibbon & Gallinaceous Bird Center. This is her second offspring, the first occurring 12 years ago. The eight-year-old sire is on loan from the Phoenix Zoo. The pair is one of only three breeding pair in North America and one of less than ten breeding pairs known in captivity. The Center recently received on loan an 11-year-old female pileated gibbon from the Gladys Porter Zoo, Brownsville, Texas. When she is housed with a male from the Center, this new pair will form an additional potential breeding pair.
